Energy Independence and Security Act (2007)

- Requires that the Federal Government purchase biofuels IF the biofuels can be shown to have a lower environmental footprint.
  - EPA's Renewable Fuel Standard
  - Fuel providers register with EPA





## Low Carbon Fuel Standard (2007)

- Law in California
- Aimed at reducing fossil fuel consumption
- Already has reduced the use of 1.8 Billion gallons of fossil fuel
- In consideration for uptake by other states





# Federal Purchasing (2009)

- Executive Order 13514
- Seeking carbon footprint and other information from vendors
- GSA's ZEF program







# Wal \* Mart (2009)



- LCA is the basis of its sustainability program
- Using LCA in Packaging Program now
  - -Data on every single package
- Seeking LCA data for all its products








- Provides LEED points for facilities using products with EPDs
- Created a plethora of new program operators without LCA knowledge
- Several standardization efforts underway
  - -ASTM (building products)
  - Leonardo Academy (EPDs in general)





# US Led Initiatives



- PCR Guidance
  - Started as an initiative of ACLCA
  - Expanded to an independent program
  - Over 40 participants from nearly 20 countries
  - <u>http://www.pcrguidance.org/</u>







- Industry Group selling over 25% of all Garments and footwear on the Globe
- EPD Program in pilot phase
  - PCR Guidance to expedite development of PCRs
  - Soon PCRs for T-shirts, trousers and coats/jackets, with EPDs starting in September





# Outlook

- Unlikely to have federal government led initiatives in the USA
- Drivers are business and NGOs
  - Significant initiatives that have gone global
- There is a "Wild West" feel to the field right now.
