GEDnet recently conducted a survey on the concept of climate declarations and to gather suggestions on improvements on existing climate declarations. The survey gave valuable suggestions on which information climate declarations should contain. The suggested improvements will be implemented in new guidelines for climate declarations within the International EPD®system.

Development of branch-related Product Category Rules (PCR) for Environmental Product Declarations (EPD)

A project with the objective to develop "ready-made" PCR modules for all relevant upstream processes is currently carried out by the Swedish Environmental Research Institute (IVL) and the Swedish Environmental Management Council (SEMCo). One of the goals is to develop "ready-made" basic PCR modules according to the two-digit level United Nations CPC-classification scheme.

One of the first "ready-made" PCR modules will be for the CPC division 46, Electrical machinery and apparatus. The work is scheduled to be finalised but the November 2008.
