PCR on the increase

The demand for PCRs, product category rules, is growing. This is proved by the many requests to the secretariat and new PCRs under development on the Environdec website. PCRs are developed through a process where a PCR moderator is appointed and existing PCRs within the The International EPD® System and in other programmes are considered. Cooperation with other interested parties is encouraged in order for the PCR to have a wide international acceptance. The PCR then undergoes a public open consultation, and a review by the Technical Committee before being published on the Environdec website. Any organisation interested in developing a new PCR is welcome to contact the Secretariat.

Chemicals giant new to EPD

One of the latest EPDs belongs to the additives manufacturer BYK-Chemie. The company, which is new in the field of environmental declarations, has recently launched four precertified EPDs. BYK is one of the world's largest suppliers in the additives and instruments sector. Coatings, printing inks and plastics industries are some of its main customers. BYK-Chemie is a business-to-business manufacturer and extracts and supplies raw materials in its own factory. The underlying LCA study for the EPD covers the upstream and manufacturing process.

Cartonboard manufacturer Reno de Medici has launched two EPDs for its chipboard. The company's coated white lined chipboard, which has been analysed in its EPDs, is made out of more than 90 per cent recovered fibres. The cartonboard is mainly used for beverages, detergents and cleaning, for food as well as non-food industries.

New General Programme Instructions to be launched

An open consultation on the programme instructions of the International EPD[®] System will take place this winter. The Technical Committee is currently working on a draft proposal of the new instructions, which will be edited by the Secretariat. The previous rules (GPI 1.0) were published in 2008 and the new version (1.1) is expected to be a minor update.

Transport a growing area

Transport is one of the fastest growing areas in the International EPD® System. So far the PCR for rail vehicles has been used three times. The Spanish company CAF, which runs the Zaragoza tram, can now boast with the first EPD to be registered for a tram. However, the PCR for rail vehicles has been used twice before, in an EPD by transport companies Bombardier and for AnsaldoBreda's EPD of the Roman Metro. CAF's tram has been redesigned to improve maintenance ease and lightness, which reduces consumption of both resources and energy during its operating life.
