Product Category Rules for Buildings published

Product Category Rules (PCR) for declaring the environmental impact of buildings have now been published in the International EPD System. The document is applicable for the European context, and aims towards compliance with the European standards:

- EN 15804 (Sustainability of construction works Environmental product declarations Core rules for the product category of construction products), and
- EN 15978 (Sustainability of construction works Assessment of environmental performance of buildings Calculation method).

The PCR is now available for any company to voluntarily develop and publish information on the life cycle environment impact of buildings in a transparent and comparable way.
